

JICMS Fall Spirit Dress Up Week

September 26-30, 2011

Please remember that regular classes will be in session each day of Fall Spirit Week. This modified Spirit Week will be dress up only for the middle school. (We do our "all out" Spirit Week in January.)

Students will be charged \$1 each day (except Friday which is FREE) for any clothing outfits that are not regular uniform dress code. The proceeds will go towards our Student Activity Fund.

***** Students who choose not to wear jeans or follow the Spirit Week day theme must be in regular school uniform.**

Dress Theme Days - We'll be taking pictures each day for the yearbook, so show your school spirit & participate! ☺

Disney Day Monday - Dress like your favorite Disney character! (Be sure to apply the JI modesty rules.) Wigs, hair dye, and hats are fine.

Pajama Day Tuesday- You may wear pajama pants (no nightgowns), a t-shirt or sweatshirt, a bathrobe over pajamas, and slippers (Bring them to put on after getting to school.). BUT, you may not fall asleep in class! Undergarments must be worn. Be comfortable, but be covered. ☺

"Wide World of Sports Wednesday" - Wear your favorite sports clothes today (warm - ups and/or basketball shorts are fine). (Mesh jerseys must have a solid shirt underneath.) For sports attire, girls may not tie their jerseys in the back. If a jersey or shirt goes past the middle of your thigh, you need to tuck it in (boys/girls). Hats are allowed. **This is also our Walk-a-Thon Day!**

"Be True to Your School Thursday"- School Color Day (Blue/Silver and/or Gray) or any James Irwin Spirit Wear. School color items must be ALL Blue or Silver/Gray or a combination of the two. Do NOT just wear something with a little of those colors in it. You may use temporary spray hair dye and other accessories to show your school colors. ☺

"Ponderosa Dress Friday" - FRIDAY WILL BE A **FREE** Dress DAY! You may wear a hat on this day. This is our official School Count Day as well! ☺

Dress Clarification - Please feel free to dress for the theme days with any of the additional clothing items listed on the back of this sheet.

Permissible:

- Jeans (No holes, patches, or frays, and properly fitting at waist), warm-ups without side snaps, cargo-style pants, long shorts, t-shirts and other modest tops (Ponderosa guidelines), scarves, suspenders, stuffed animals (if part of an outfit), and/or dress up (in line with NJHS dress code).
- Leggings and/or tights may be worn under knee length shorts or skirts/dresses if part of your theme day dress.
- Wigs, hair dye, and hats are okay on designated days. ☺

Reminders of what is not permissible:

- No sleeveless shirts (unless a t-shirt is worn underneath), no tank tops or cami's without an overshirt, no cut offs, no hats (except on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday), no sunglasses, no hoodies (unless JI hoodies on school color day or to wear outside for the walk-a-thon), no flip-flops, no sandals.
- Leggings and/or tights may **ONLY** be worn under knee length shorts or skirts if part of your theme day dress.
- No sweat pants. Loose-fitting warm-ups are okay.
- No cross-dressing.
- No vampires, skulls, or negative symbols or words.
- No low-cut, tight, or revealing clothing. **MODESTY RULES APPLY.** If you purchase a costume, you may have to add to it to be within JI modesty rules.
- Any questionable items you may want to wear must be pre-approved. (Bring them to school for Mrs. V. or Mr. C. to check **PRIOR** to the day you want to wear them during Spirit Week.)

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
