RESOLUTION TO COMPLY WITH 2023 D49 MLO

Whereas the Board of Directors of El Paso County School District 49 has voted to place a ballot measure on the 2023 general election ballot; and

Whereas that ballot measure includes a binding commitment that proceeds from the measure will be applied exclusively to teacher compensation; and

Whereas the Board of Directors of James Irwin Charter Schools recognizes the value of paying teachers a competitive wage; and

Whereas the Board of Directors of El Paso County School District 49 has determined that disbursement of the MLO proceeds shall be contingent on each school's commitment to comply with the ballot provision that 100% of proceeds will apply to teacher compensation; and

Whereas the specific disbursement and allocation of those funds to teachers shall be at the discretion of each charter school's administration and governance authority, subject to an audit by the citizens' oversight committee of the District 49 Accountability and Advisory Committee;

Therefore, be it resolved that

The Board of Directors of James Irwin Charter Schools by adoption of this resolution, do make a legally binding financial commitment to apply 100% of proceeds from the 2023 MLO to teacher compensation; and
