Another important reminder is that absences, whether excused or unexcused, count in the tally of absences.

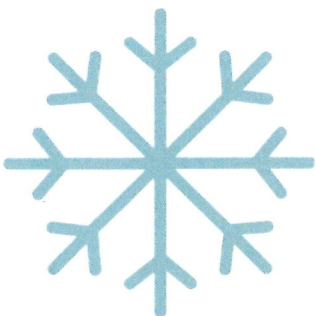


Hours of Operation
