
Cell Phone Policy Reminder


-Cell phones can be in students' backpacks or lockers, powered down during the day.


-During the school day, cell phones should not be on a student's person.

Select how you prefer to be contacted for each message type and then click "Save". Weather delays and closures are sent as Emergency messages.


