


Cell Phone Policy Reminder



Dear PTEC Parent or Guardian,

State and federal laws require students to take standardized assessments in the instructional areas of English language arts, mathematics, and science. Parents or guardians wishing to exempt their student from an assessment may request to do so. Please note that the SAT is one of the postsecondary readiness assessments that can be used to meet graduation requirements. PTEC uses these assessments and others to determine the achievement and growth of our students, ensure appropriate instruction and resources for students, evaluate the effectiveness of curriculum and instruction, and determine the performance level of our school in comparison to the district and state.

The anticipated assessment schedule is listed below. Changes may be necessary due to weather related delays and closures. Please note that the Extended Time groups are specific to students with a 504 Plan or IEP. If you have questions about state required testing, please contact kelly.dias@jamesirwin.org.
